NARFE-PAC News – Don Binder

What is NARFE-PAC? With a major election behind us and new year ahead, good time for a refresher and/or clarification for new members. As outlined in NARFE's literature, NARFE-PAC is a separate, segregated NARFE fund of voluntary contributions from NARFE members specifically for political purposes. NARFE's four elected national officers constitute NARFE's Political Action Committee (PAC), and are responsible for deciding which House 8319 and Senate candidates will receive PAC contributions.

NARFE-PAC contributions help fund NARFE's political arm in Washington. Its sole purpose is to protect the benefits of individuals with a vested interest in the federal government's civilian retirement systems. The PAC helps elect U.S. senators and representatives sympathetic to the concerns of federal employees and retirees, and who support fair and equitable federal retirement programs.

Again, with a major election behind us and a new year ahead with the potential for benefit changes, it is an important time to consider donating to our PAC to help maintain it as a strong political arm. Questions? Call me at 509-585-1393.
