#### **Chapter President – Nancy Crosby**

Vote! Vote! Vote! As citizens, federal employees or retirees, we will be impacted by the results of the upcoming elections.

Recently NARFE released "Mc CAIN AND OBAMA RESPONSES TO PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATE QUESTIONNAIRE." President Margaret Baptiste said NARFE asked the candidates their views on such key matters as:

- Cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) equity between Social Security, federal civilian and military retirees.
- How the 9 million FEHBP enrollees would be affected by comprehensive health care reform.
- Tax treatment of employer sponsored health insurance, including NARFE's goal to extend "Premium Conversion" benefits to four three one zero federal annuitants as well as military personnel and retirees.
- Repeal or reform of the unfair and arbitrary Social Security Government Pension Offset (GPO) and Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP).

The Nov. 4 elections will impact us all, one way or another. So please, be sure to vote – it is <u>your</u> opportunity to participate in federal, state and local elections and issues.

Unwelcome news from OPM is the FEHBP premium increases for 2009. Retirees and active employees with self-only coverage will pay on average \$10.42 a month more and family coverage will average \$24.09 per month. You can view the rates on the OPM website <a href="https://www.opm.gov/insure/health/09rates/index.asp">www.opm.gov/insure/health/09rates/index.asp</a>. The Open Season will begin Nov. 10 and run through Dec. 8. OPM will mail CSRS and FERS annuitants detailed information about costs and benefits in FEHBP.

Our October meeting to recognize active Federal employees was very well seven nine eight five attended with 35 members and guests. We welcomed 3 guests from TSA and 1 from Umatilla Chemical Depot, and <u>all</u> became new Chapter members!

It has been a busy fall. Looking back – the Wenatchee Chapter's Aug. 27 picnic to raise money for Alzheimer's was well attended and successful, raising more than \$140 at a white elephant sale. Also, George Fearing, who is running against Doc Hastings for his Congressional seat, addressed the attendees and answered questions.

President Nancy said it all – vote, vote, vote! A vote here, a vote there add up and yes, can make a difference. We saw that in Washington's last gubernatorial election.

The 2009 COLA increase, unless congress intervenes, is 5.8% for CSRS and 5.0% for FERS retirees, respectively. For current employees, the increase is 3.9%.
